Dress and Grooming

While fashions change, the reason for being in school does not. Students are in school to learn. Any fashion (dress, accessory, or hairstyle) that disrupts the educational process or presents a safety risk will not be permitted. Personal expression is permitted within these general guidelines.

Students are required to wear the school uniform every day.

The colors are as follows:

Bottoms

K-9th Grade: Khaki

Pants
Shorts
Jumpers
Skirts
Skorts

Tops

Kindergarten-5th Grade: Dark Blue
6th-8th Grade: Burgundy
9th Grade: Black

Polo Shirt
Collared button-down shirt or blouse
Turtlenecks can be worn under the
Collared shirt only.

**All shorts, skirts, jumpers, and skorts must not be any shorter than 1 inch above the knee.*

Sweaters/Jackets

K-5th Grade: Dark Blue or White
6th-8th Grade: Burgundy or White
9th Grade: Black or White

NO HOODIES may be worn at any time in the school.

Shoes

NO open toe shoes are allowed. This includes flip-flops, sandals, slides, and slippers.

If a student has selected a manner of appearance that is disruptive to the educational process or presents a risk to themselves or others, they may be removed from the educational setting.

Students may wear approved CATAwear in lieu of a uniform shirt.
