Research has found that after school programs are a valuable asset for increasing student performance. Findings have concluded that middle school students who regularly attended an after school program showed improved academic achievement, higher school attendance and lower drop-out rates (Fashola, 1998). After school participation also results in an increase of positive social and academic choices.

The evident benefits of after school programming has led Columbus Arts & Technology Academy to provide the 21st Century After School Program again this year. Our program is open to 6-8th graders (5th graders will be admitted in October) at CATA for no additional fee. 21st Century runs from 3:30 to 6:00 p.m. every school day .

The 21st Century After School Program offers students a chance to expand their horizons, cultivate abilities in leadership and improve their reading and math scores. Our students will have the opportunity to work with community partners at both on and off site workshops and field trips. Attendees will be provided with daily homework help, silent reading time and engaging math and reading academic lessons in an effort to increase achievement.
