



Uniform Policy

While fashions change, the reason for being in school does not. Students are in school to learn. **If a student has a manner of appearance that is disruptive to the educational process or presents a risk to themselves or others, they may be removed from the educational setting. All final decisions will be determined by the Head of School.** Personal expression is permitted within these general guidelines. Students are required to wear the school uniform every day. The colors are as follows:

- **Grades K-5:** Navy top with khaki or black slacks
- **Grades 6-8:** Maroon top with khaki or black slacks
- **Grades 9-12:** Black top with khaki or black slacks

Uniform Clarifications & Qualifications

- Uniform tops must include a collar and can be a polo shirt, button-down, or blouse.
- Long-sleeved shirts may be worn under collared shirts.
- Khaki or black slacks include pants; shorts, jumpers, skirts, and skorts.
- Shorts, skirts, jumpers, and skorts must be below extended arms and fingertip length.
- Leggings are prohibited except under approved bottoms.
- Coats may only be worn outdoors; jackets with a hood are not permitted.
- Sweatshirts (without a hood) are permitted, but must match uniform shirt colors.
- Labels and designs must be no larger than a credit card.
- Ripped clothing revealing skin is not permitted.
- Bonnets, du-rags, night scarves, hats, and bandanas are prohibited.

Shoes

- Any closed toe shoe is acceptable. No slippers, slides, flip flops, sandals or crocs (with or without straps) are permitted.

CATA Wear

- Approved CATA t-shirts or sweatshirts may be worn unaltered with uniform bottoms
